- Priority given to proposals that bring learning to life and create inspirational and impactful student experiences.
- ▶ These are typically for items will be executed in the 22-23 school year.

MIDDLEBROOK GEOGRAPHY BEE

- Parief description: The Middlebrook Geography Bee is a school wide competition that replaces the National Geographic Geography Bee. The grant request is for medals and trophies for our 9 finalists. The school championship would take place some time near the end of the year in June.
